Domain: A major topic in math studies. Domains categorize ideas in math. Number Sense (NS), Geometry (G), Expressions and Equations (EE), and Operations and Algebraic Thinking (OA) are all examples of domains. Every domain is broken down into smaller concepts, called standards.

Standard: A standard is a bite-sized concept. We learn many standards to learn about a major idea in math. For example, when you learn how to add, subtract, multiply, and divide, you are learning concepts described in standards. Since adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing are all mathematical operations, those concepts are all part of the domain, Operations and Algebraic Thinking.
